Visible Learning at Queensferry CP

Staff have been busy this year working alongside our colleagues at Ty Ffynnon, Bryn Deva, Cae'r Nant, Golftyn and CQHS to develop children's understanding of what they are learning, how to go about learning it and how to evaluate the progress they are making.
