Upcoming Events

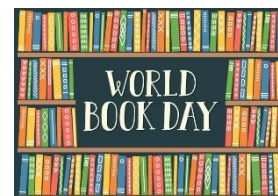


We will be having our usual Welsh week the first week back after half term. Our school Eisteddfod will be on the afternoon of Friday 7th March
